

Roadworks are starting in your area soon.

What's happening, where and when?

What: Utilising the JCB POTHOLE PRO to undertake essential carriageway works.

Where: Jubilee Close-Byfield

When: 13th- 17th May

Times: Working hours 09:00-15:00

How long: 5 Shifts

Traffic Management: These works will only allow access only. **Please do not park on the carriageway during these works. We reserve the right to tow away any vehicles restricting the works.**

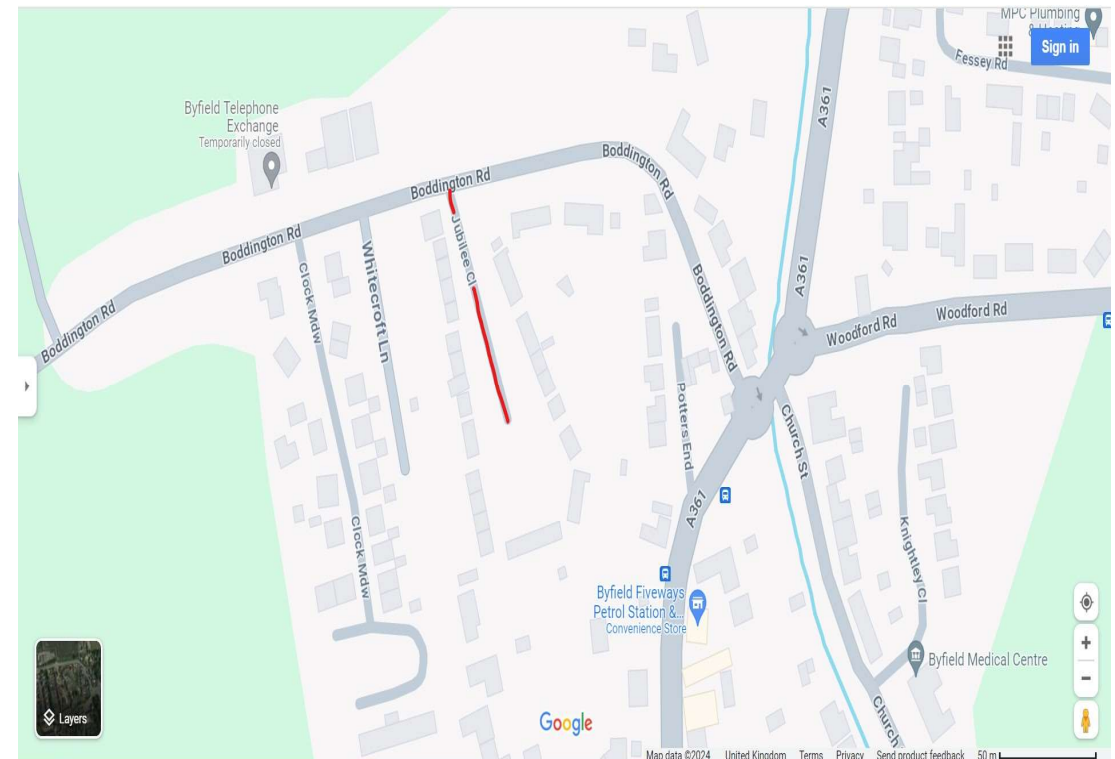
Residents: Vehicle access will be limited for residents. **Residents with properties within the road closure will be escorted through by our traffic management contractors.**

Emergency Vehicles: We aim to maintain access for emergency vehicles where safe to do so.

Pedestrians and Cyclists: Cyclists will be asked to follow the diversion route. Alternatively, cyclists can dismount their bike and walk on the footway. The footway will be open for pedestrians.

Public Transport: No bus stops will be affected.
